No Renovations

Fiberglass pool owners enjoy peace of mind knowing their pool will last forever! Gunite or vinyl liner pool owners have their monthly pool payment, higher electrical bills, higher chemical bills and must save up their cash or use their credit card for renovations and re-linings about every 7-10 years.

Typical Gunite Pool Plaster Resurfacing: \$5,500

A properly maintained surface of a gunite pool has a life expectancy of 7-10 years. However, with each acid wash, a layer of plaster is etched away, making the need for resurfacing a big expense.

Typical Vinyl Liner Replacement: \$3,700

Well maintained vinyl liners may need to be replaced every 4 years. Adverse pH conditions and strong ultraviolet light rapidly deteriorate vinyl liners, reducing their life span drastically.

Fiberglass Resurfacing: \$0

Fiberglass pool owners never pay for renovations as long as pool chemistry is properly maintained.

Fewer chemicals

The pH value in a fiberglass pool is more stable because there's not a chemical reaction occuring between the surface and the water. Acid is rarely (if ever) used, so chlorine demand is significantly less. A fiberglass pool typically uses about 70% less chemicals each month! Algae can only grow on the surface of the fiberglass pool and is simply wiped off and circulated away.

In a gunite pool, a chemical reaction occurs between the plaster and the water, causing alkalinity from the plaster surface to leach out into the water. This reaction constantly raises the pH value. Acid or soda ash, plus additional chlorine are used to combat the constant change. Algae that grows from within the pores of the plaster must be removed with muriatic acid. At a cost of \$60-\$100 per month, pool service companies make a good living maintaining gunite pools.

Fiberglass pool owners find caring for their pool is easy and love the idea they NEVER need to pay \$60-\$100 per month for pool service! Water chemistry is intimidating enough without the pool surface compounding the problem. A fiberglass pool is easier to maintain no degree required!

Lower electric bills

Gunite pools require 8-12 hours of circulation per day. Dirt hides in pores of plaster, so frequent brushing and vacuuming is required. As the pool gets older and rougher and the plaster surface ages, the circulation time increases! The smooth satin surface of a fiberglass pool has ageless beauty.

Fiberglass pools circulate in just a few hours each day. The satin smooth surface of a fiberglass pool offers little resistance to water movement. Water moves quickly and circulates with fewer hours of pump operation. With no pores in which dirt can settle, fiberglass pools look and stay cleaner too.

Higher electrical costs are rarely calculated into the overall price of a pool, but they should be! You may already cringe when the electric bill arrives each month; Add the electrical demand of a pool pump to your bill and it can either make or break your pool budget. Choosing a fiberglass pool won't break your budget!

Facts & Myths

Here are some facts on the most common misunderstandings about fiberglass pools.

Fact Fiberglass pools last forever

Imagine throwing away a fiberglass boat. No way! Quality boats don't ever wear out. Provided it is moderately maintained, a quality fiberglass pool will last forever, looking very much like the day it was installed! Once nestled properly in the ground, they will remain beautiful and functional forever! We use some of the same resin and materials used to build underground fiberglass gasoline storage tanks at gas stations around the world. This fact alone confirms just how strong fiberglass products are.

Myth

Fiberglass pools don't look like a real pool

We always snicker at this one because fiberglass pools are real pools. In fact, a fiberglass pool that has been installed with a cantilevered deck and perhaps optional waterline tile is impossible to distinguish from a brand new plaster pool. To tell the difference, one must reach in the water and touch the satin smooth surface. The big difference is that the fiberglass pool will retain its good looks, whereas a plaster pool will begin to look pitted, rusted, and blotchy after just a few short years.

Myth Fiberglass pools "pop" out of the ground

This statement is a common scare tactic that the vinyl and gunite industry uses to deter potential clients away from fiberglass pools. The gunite industry loses all credibility after the customer gets the facts. Lots of people ask this question, and we, as manufacturers, are happy to set the record straight!

Any watertight vessel (in this case, your pool) will float, regardless of what it is made of, provided the vessel is empty and there is water under it. This same "principal of displacement" is what allows heavy concrete barges to float as easily as lightweight fiberglass boats. What overcomes displacement? The weight of the water! This is why boats that have sunk do not "pop" out of the water!

The reasons to drain a pool in the first place (resurfacing, acid washing to remove algae, or draining to correct a severe out-of-balance chemical situation), don't apply to fiberglass pools. So, it is rare to ever need to completely drain a fiberglass pool. However, vinyl and gunite pools do require draining for major maintenance and renovation. The truth is that the majority of the pools that become dislodged (float or pop) are actually gunite or vinyl liner pools.

Fact/Myth

Fiberglass pools are cheaper

The answer is, truthfully: yes and no. In many areas of the country, the purchase price of a fiberglass pool is about the same or slightly more than an equivalent gunite pool. A fiberglass pool is more expensive than a vinyl liner pool, and should be! The materials are more expensive, but fiberglass last forever! Any uninformed buyer may mistakenly assume fiberglass pools fall in the temporary, above-ground price range, which is not true. Fiberglass savings are realized monthly in electrical and chemical costs. The higher expenses of a vinyl or gunite pool add up quickly. In areas where fiberglass pools initially cost more, the difference is quickly made up after a few years of paying these bills.


It is important to have your excavator review the Dig Diagram prior to excavation. All dimensions are approximate. A 4" over-dig must be added to the bottom for the stone, along with a 1' by 2' trench from the pool hole to the area of the equipment placement for plumbing and wiring.

Benefits of swimming

Weight loss

Swimming is a great way to burn calories. And the more calories you burn, the more fat gets mobilized. As a result, you will start losing the extra flab in your body. It is also helpful for those with joint pain or arthritis. Scientists conducted an experiment and found that swimming ameliorates osteoporosis, helps improve bone mass, and strengthens the bones.

Improves heart health

The number of people suffering from heart diseases has skyrocketed in the recent past. So, if you lead a sedentary lifestyle and feel that going to the gym is dreadful, try having fun in the cool blue water. This aerobic exercise will help improve your heart health and protect you from potential cardiovascular diseases. In fact, various studies have found that swimming is one of the best exercises for keeping your heart in good condition.

Improves flexibility

Flexibility is the ability to move your joints to their full range. When you swim, you use your limbs and core to propel your body forward and stay afloat. Swimming every day helps improve whole body flexibility and, as a result, reduces joint pain.

Improves body coordination

It's a no-brainer that swimming requires a lot of coordination between the legs, arms, head, chest, and eyes. Be it for recreational, therapeutic, or competition purpose, swimming helps improve your whole body movement and coordination between the limbs and the core.

Improves sleep quality

If you have difficulty in sleeping, you must start swimming. Swimming is a full-body aerobic exercise, and if have ever spent some time in the water, you know how exhausting it can be. That's because your entire body, along with your brain, works constantly while swimming. This is precisely why you will start to sleep better.

Supports mental health

Stress, anxiety, and depression are mental health issues that you should never ignore. Scientists have found that swimming can help uplift mood and treat various serious psychological issues.

Swim strokes



The freestyle

is swam in a horizontal position with the body facing down. The body rolls from one side to the other, always turning to the side of the arm that is currently pulling in the water. The head remains in a neutral position, face down, except when breathing.

The backstroke

uses alternating and opposite arm movements. As one arm pulls through the water from an overhead position to the hip, the other arm recovers above the water from the hip to the overhead position and vice versa. The legs perform a flutter kick, similar to the one used in freestyle.

The **butterfly**



Extend your arms above your head. Pull hands toward your body in a semicircle, with palms outward. Push your palms backward. Pull your arms along your sides and past your hips.... Recover. Finish the pull by dragging thumbs on your thighs as you finish the stroke.





Treading water

To scull water, raise your arms sideways to shoulder height and then move your arms forward and back, pushing against the water with your hands. The pressure your arms and hands exert on the water creates some buoyancy that keeps your body afloat.

Flutter **kick**

Push one leg down in the water by slightly bending the knee and pushing the water down on top of your foot, repeat this motion on your alternate leg. When doing it correctly, the power driven in your hip will naturally move the knee slightly. Do not forget to point and slightly turn inwards your toes to also minimize dragging within the water.

Back float



You need to align your body with the water -ideally, your body should start off in a position that is almost parallel to the water or bottom of the pool. Lift your chin, and make sure the water line is at mid-cheek. Stay centered, lift your chest and arch your back slightly.


